### Child Welfare Transformation Design Committee Suggested Agenda Items for September Meeting

Below is a list of the proposed Agenda Items for the September 16-17 meeting to be discussed during the conference call:

- Child Welfare in Washington State
  - The purpose of this session is to ensure that everyone on the committee understands the entire system from the time a child enters care through the child exiting care. This session will include all parties involved - legal, state, provider, etc.
- The Children in Washington's Care
  - The purpose of this session is to ensure everyone understands who the children are within Washington's child welfare system. Topics will include age, race, geographic location, length of stay, in-home vs. out-of-home, etc.
- Outcomes
  - This session will provide a complete overview of federal and state outcome measures, as well as Braam benchmarks/measures. It will highlight where there is alignment and misalignment.
- Necessary Services
  - This session will pull from the most recent studies (Partners for Our Children, JLARC, WSU, etc.) highlighting what workers, birth parents, foster parents, etc. say they most need.
- Performance-Based Contracting
  - This session will provide an overview of the types of Performance-Based Contracting that are currently being used across the country. Examples from several states will be provided.
- Timeline for the Department of Social and Health Service Children's Administration
  - Children's Administration will provide a timeline for the next 18 months and beyond. This will inform the committee as to when specific decisions will need to be made.
- Review of Advisory Committees
  - The committee will review the Advisory Committees charters one last time, discuss structure and ground rules for committees, etc.
